



## Nurse Program Coordinator – Victoria

### About the role

We are currently seeking a Registered Nurse to work full time (35hrs/week) on a one-year contract with the Mobile Health Clinic in Victoria. We have a unique opportunity to work in a rewarding and challenging work environment with a strong focus on leadership and community partnership.

- A fully functional mobile clinic giving you the opportunity to provide quality care in various locations around greater Victoria including Sooke and Sidney

### Job description

Reporting directly to the Director of National Operations in Montreal, the Nurse Program Coordinator represents Doctors of the World and is the local lead on this Victoria project. They must advocate for and act as the bridge between our vulnerable community members and the existing public health care system, in addition to maintaining excellent relationships with community partners.

### Key duties and responsibilities:

- Provide ongoing primary care to vulnerable and marginalized community members
- Implement strategies to promote health and prevent illness
- Practice autonomously while performing comprehensive health assessments using sound clinical judgement, diagnostic and therapeutic skills
- Be competent in the health care management of various acute and chronic conditions
- Distribute harm reduction supplies
- Make appropriate referrals to other service providers and programs
- Establish and maintain relationships with partners and key stakeholders which includes; regional health authorities, government, and large corporate sponsors
- Contribute to policy and procedure management while maintaining the functionality of the mobile health clinic

### Working conditions

- Working hours vary and may include shifts up to 12 hours per day, working schedule is Monday to Friday
- The Mobile Health Clinic travels to a variety of locations each with different physical and social environments, work is performed primarily inside the vehicle as well as some street outreach

- Current registration as a RN with BCCNP
- Bachelor of Science in Nursing- BScN with remote certified practice or willingness to complete STI certification
- Current CPR
- Minimum of 12 months fulltime equivalent as a community nurse
- Have a BC MSP billing number (or be eligible to get one)
- Valid drivers' licence with a clean abstract
- Extensive knowledge of existing local services and pathways
- Excellent interpersonal communication and leadership skills
- Proficient in EMR systems
